REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE

PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE BASELINE STUDY OF UNDERSERVED, ISOLATED AND VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES AND SECTORS IN BARMM

- 1. The Office of the Chief Minister, Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (OCM-BARMM), through the General Appropriation Act of the Bangsamoro 2023 intends to apply the sum of Two Million Eight Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PHP 2,833,500.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for Procurement of Consulting Services for the baseline study of underserved, isolated, and vulnerable communities and sectors in BARMM. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
- 2. The **OCM-BARMM** now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for the **baseline study of underserved, isolated, and vulnerable communities and sectors in BARMM**¹. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **November 22, 2023, during office hours** at **Procurement Service, 1F, Office of the Chief Minister-Annex Building, Bangsamoro Government Center, Cotabato City.** Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
- 3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from **OCM-BARMM** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours (8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday).
- 4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **November 15 to December 6, 2023** from the address below upon payment of the

applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Five Thousand Pesos (PHP 5,000.00)**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The short list shall consist of **three (3) prospective bidders**² who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

6. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

- 7. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the *Quality Based Evaluation/Selection* (*QBE/QBS*) procedure. The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders.
- 8. The contract shall be completed within **90 calendar days**.
- 9. The **OCM-BARMM** reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
